



PITTSBURGH INTERNATIONAL AUTO SHOW
RETURNS TO DAVID LAWRENCE CONVENTION CENTER

The largest four day public show in Pittsburgh, the Pittsburgh International Auto Show, returns to the David Lawrence Convention Center on February 16-19, 2018. The Auto Show is the only show that actually carpets the entire convention center, to make it an even warmer, more inviting venue in the middle of February.

The Auto Show is also making this event the most affordable, family event by offering free parking and free shuttle busses to/from Rivers Casino (21 and over), half price tickets for children 6-16, \$2 discounts for seniors and military personnel, and half price for everyone on President's Day, Monday, February 19.

In addition to having every new car/truck on the market on display, there are numerous other attractions for the whole family, including celebrity appearances and autographs, team mascots, interactive simulators and exhibits, and more.

One of the most popular new attractions, introduced a couple of years ago, is the "Galleria Exotica!"
